CH ONNAY

The only non-Apellation vineyard of the estate being classified as a Vin de France (a French Wine). This vintage is composed of young grapes planted by Pierre-Yves and Olivier. We want to give this vintage a fruity and young feel for a fresh and easy-wine-drinking experience. With appetizers, grilled fish, seafood, Burgundy snails and goat cheese from Macon, this wine will delight the Chardonnay enthusiast.

AGE Planted in 1988

AREA 0.30 ha

VINTAGE CUTTING Single and acute Guyot

HARVESTING PROCESS Machine

RECEPTION 100% Sorting and destemming

CRUSHING Slow pneumatic at low pressure

VINIFICATION In vats

FERMENTATION Controlled temperature of about 12°C and 18°C

BOTTLED Several times on the estate from February to July
